One overall trials champion covering all classes as listed below.

Paid up club members only eligible to score points.

There will be 5 point scoring events with a riders best 4 performances to count. The British Bike 2 day is stand alone event so there are no points available at this event.

For those who ride different classes at different events all points are accumulative.

Event Dates :- March 17th Lambs Lair, April 21stTBD, July 27th Batcombe, October 6th Emborough, December 15th Binegar.

Machine eligibility: -

Pre 70 original machines & replicas, including European machines but European two strokes must be pre 1960 models, 1961 on will categorized classed as twin-shock. Any twin-shock machine except modified mono's with disc brakes. Plus riders over 60 on mono's. -

Classes :-

- 1 Pre 70 up to 300cc
- 2 Pre 70 over 300cc
- 3 Rigid
- 4 Twin-shock
- 5 Riders over 60 mono's

Note - Riders on the 'C' route will combined as a single group no class differentiation.

Points will be awarded separately in each class as follows subject to a minimum of 3 starters :-

1st - 10

2nd - 9

3rd - 8

4th - 7

5th - 6

6th - 5

7th - 4

8th - 3

0 - 3

9th - 2 10th - 1

Bonus points relative to number or riders in class -

Starters 12 plus - 2 bonus points for first 3 finishers

Starters 8 to 11 - 1 bonus point for first 2 finishers

Starters 3 to 7 - no bonus points

Ties awarded = points (i.e. equal 1st get 10 points next finisher gets 8 points (3rd place)

If only 3 starters points will be 8, 6 & 5

If only 1 or 2 starters points will be 6 & 5

Competitors under 60 on monos can ride as guests but are ineligible to score points.
